EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OUTLINE

Dried Fruit (Export Inspection Charge) Bill 1981

This Bill provides for a charge to apply to dried fruit exported from Australia.

Provision is made for the imposition of charges and for rates of charge to be prescribed subject to a maximum of \$11.00 per tonne. Different rates of charge may be prescribed for different classes of dried fruit. The Bill includes provision for exemptions from the charge to be made in regulations. The Bill also specifies by whom the charge is payable.
