EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

OUTLINE

Dairy Products (Export Inspection Charge) Bill 1982

This Bill provides for a charge to apply to Dairy Products inspected under the provisions of the Exports (Dairy Produce) Regulations.

Provision is made for the imposition of charges and for the rate of charge to be prescribed subject to a maximum of \$5.00 per tonne. The Bill includes provision for exemptions from the charge to be made in regulations. The Bill also specifies by whom the charge is payable.

(3)	Provides for the maximum rate of charge which can apply to dairy products.
7	Makes the charge payable by the person who fur ${\bf n}$ is the export notice.
8	Provides for regulations relating to the charge, exemptions from the charge and the rates of charge.
